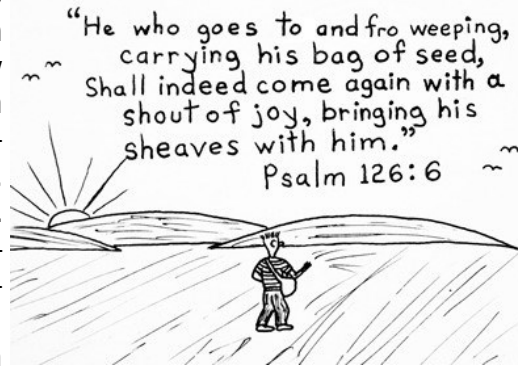


"A Random Encouragement"

Eleven years ago, a student at the University of Waterloo came to a talk I gave on evidence for the existence of God. He was at the point of putting his faith in Christ, but also had major doubts, assuming that science had pretty much destroyed the credibility of Christianity. By the time my talk was over, those doubts were gone. I did not know anything about this, however, until just a few weeks ago when he introduced himself to me at the Kitchener-Waterloo Home Education Association's conference, where I gave three seminars on logic and apologetics. He told me that my talk had been a major, positive turning point in his life. He went on to grow as a new Christian and find a church home. Now, he and his Christian wife are raising their children to be men and women of God. During the past two semesters, our Canadian student ministry, we saw 250 students put their faith in Christ and 2,500 students in discipleship groups, and much fruit for eternity.
