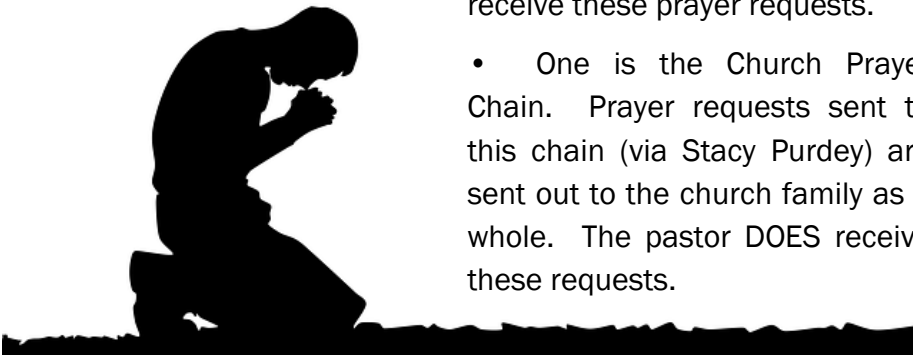

Thank you. Thank you. Thank you.

I just returned Tanzania and Kenya, where I met many people who specifically asked me to thank you on their behalf.

I met **40** farmers with 1 and 2 acre farms. With training you funded, they are growing twice the yield of their neighbours, and yet improving the land as they go—the impact of new Conservation Agriculture practices is so obvious their neighbours are copying them.

Our partners introduced me to more than **200 members of 8 Village Savings and Loans groups**. Each one is made up of up to 30 people—and more than 85% are women. Small shop keepers with \$25 of inventory and some vegetables. Small-scale farmers. Seamstresses. Block makers. Craftsmen. Goat and cow herdsman. Door-to-door vendors. All member seeking to see their lives change for the better. Together, they turn our training and encouragement—and a steel box with three locks—into an engine for transforming their futures.

Our partners thank you, profoundly. Down-to-earth and close to the need, **pastors, agency and denominational leaders** add tremendous value to your money. Pastors are energized by your commitment to the compassion of Christ. Their small rural churches grow as their parishioners succeed, increase attendance and give more. Denominational leaders see the immediate and long-term benefits, and ask how we can expand out programs.

And others are also grateful—thousands of children, women and men, who don't know that it's you, but know that someone is helping improve their lives. **So, I say a heartfelt "thank you" on their behalf.**
