Sermon Notes  
Growing in Holiness: Obedience

Joshua 7:1-26

Series: Holy Living for a Holy People - #5

1. “No matter how many persons we touch with the gospel we have failed unless, along with the message of invitation, we have boldly declared the exceeding \_\_\_\_\_ of man and the transcendent \_\_\_\_\_ of the Most High God.” - A.W. Tozer
2. The conquest of Jericho required nothing more of the Israelites than \_\_\_\_\_ to God’s commands.
3. In return, the city and all that was in it, was to be \_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord.
4. Something devoted to the Lord was to be \_\_\_\_\_ given over to Him. Nothing was to be kept back for a person’s personal use. This is the language of \_\_\_\_\_ and offering.
5. For someone, or something, to be devoted to the Lord requires a complete \_\_\_\_\_ of that person, or thing, to the Lord.
6. If we are in Christ Jesus, God has a \_\_\_\_\_ on our lives because it is He who \_\_\_\_\_ us from the penalty of sin.
7. As a result, \_\_\_\_\_, matters deeply to God.
8. When we desire our own way, more than we desire to do the Lord’s will, then something other than God has taken the place of \_\_\_\_\_ in our hearts. We have created an \_\_\_\_\_ out of it and God will not tolerate that in His holy people.
9. When Achan took the items that were to be devoted to God, it was a sign of what was going on in his \_\_\_\_\_. He \_\_\_\_\_ for himself that which had been intended for God.
10. In doing so, Achan broke \_\_\_\_\_ with God, and was no longer walking in \_\_\_\_\_ to Him.
11. How do you respond to failure, defeat, or unexpected setbacks as you pursue the tasks which the Lord has set before you? Joshua and the Elders of Israel \_\_\_\_\_ out to God for \_\_\_\_\_ to what had happened to them.
12. They waited for the Lord to \_\_\_\_\_ to them and to \_\_\_\_\_ them what they ought to do before they reacted to what had taken place.
13. The account of Achan’s sin reveals that none of us sin in \_\_\_\_\_ from those around us.
14. The \_\_\_\_\_ of our sin extend far beyond ourselves because sin has a way of affecting the whole camp.
15. “\_\_\_\_\_” is an ugly word conveying a sense of violence and desecration. Yet this is the word that God chose to describe the impact of Achan’s sin.
16. God was calling His people to \_\_\_\_\_. He was establishing a people that were meant to be to His glory and for testimony to the nations of the world.
17. Sin made the Israelites liable to \_\_\_\_\_ and threatened to \_\_\_\_\_ them from the power, provision, and presence of God.
18. The willingness of God to \_\_\_\_\_ from His people graphically illustrates the seriousness of sin in His eyes.
19. The weight of \_\_\_\_\_ is not to be found by weighing it against other sins but rather by weighing it against the perfect \_\_\_\_\_ of God.
20. Like the Israelites, we will not grow in holiness apart from \_\_\_\_\_ to what God has commanded us.
21. Sin, which is really \_\_\_\_\_ against God and a form of \_\_\_\_\_ in which we proclaim that our way is better than God’s way, must be dealt with because ...
