Join us for a Mother's Day Brunch following the service on Sunday, May 8th.


All are welcome!

## Sermon Notes:

### Word of God - 1 Thessalonians 2:13-16 - Series: 1 Thessalonians - #11

1. \_\_\_\_\_ of Canadians identify as Christian but only \_\_\_\_\_ of them read the Bible at least once/month. \_\_\_\_\_ believe all the major religions teach the same thing. Only \_\_\_\_\_ say the Bible is relevant today.
2. Our lack of engagement with the Bible is a problem because the Bible **IS** the \_\_\_\_\_.
3. The word of God is \_\_\_\_\_, meaning it lacks nothing that is needed for us to know God, or His purposes in redemption.
4. God \_\_\_\_\_ Himself to each new generation through His timeless, unchanging, word.
5. The Bible is our only source of absolute, un-subjective, \_\_\_\_\_.
6. Jesus said, <sup>4</sup> ... Man does not live on \_\_\_\_\_ alone, but on every \_\_\_\_\_ that comes from the mouth of God. (Matthew 4:4, NIV84)
7. Our lack of engagement with the Bible is troubling because the word of God is essential for our \_\_\_\_\_.
8. God “chose to give us birth through the \_\_\_\_\_, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all He created.” (James 1:18)
9. For you have been \_\_\_\_\_, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. (1 Peter 1:22-23, NIV84)
10. Our lack of engagement with the Bible is disturbing because the word of God is necessary for our \_\_\_\_\_.
11. The will of God is not that we remain in bondage to \_\_\_\_\_, but rather that we be set free to live life as life was \_\_\_\_\_ to be.
12. The word of God is living and active ... it \_\_\_\_\_ the thoughts and the attitudes of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)
13. We are not to be conformed to this world but to be transformed by the renewing of our mind. Our minds are renewed and transformed as we \_\_\_\_\_, consider, and \_\_\_\_\_ the word of God.
14. Without \_\_\_\_\_ ourselves to the word of God, our lives will look much like the lives of those who deny or reject God.
15. All Scripture is \_\_\_\_\_ and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)
16. Three main factors determine our engagement with the Scriptures: \_\_\_\_\_ that the Bible is the word of God, frequent \_\_\_\_\_ about the Scriptures, and the \_\_\_\_\_ established by regular attendance at a local church.

  - A. Confidence that the Bible is God's word and relevant for us today.
  - B. Regular Conversations centered on the Scriptures.
  - C. Regular attendance at the worship services of the church.
