## Sermon Notes:

### The Work of Christ

John 6:1-15

Series: Palm Sunday

1. Because of their \_\_\_\_\_ notions about what God should, or should not be doing, the people miss out on what God **IS** doing.
2. Rather than making God in our own image, we need to let our understanding of God be informed by the Word of \_\_\_\_\_, that He has given us.
3. Our understanding of God, this world, and our place in it, needs to be shaped by \_\_\_\_\_ rather than attempting to fit Scripture into our \_\_\_\_\_.
4. "For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and \_\_\_\_\_." (Colossians 1:16, NIV84)
5. Jesus is the light that will shine into the darkness of men's hearts and re-veal \_\_\_\_\_ the truth about their condition before God.
6. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ our spiritual thirst like nothing will ever quench our physical thirst.
7. The hunger that Jesus satisfies is much grander than the \_\_\_\_\_ sustenance we receive from a simple loaf of bread.
8. Jesus says that "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have \_\_\_\_\_, and have it to the \_\_\_\_\_." (John 10:10, NIV84)
9. The crowds followed Jesus for what they could get from Him – \_\_\_\_\_ for their stomachs and \_\_\_\_\_ for their bodies.
10. "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of \_\_\_\_\_. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God." (John 6:67-69, NIV84)
11. Do we understand what the abundant life consists of?
12. Jesus says, "I am the \_\_\_\_\_ that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world." (John 6:51, NIV84)
13. The freedom Jesus brings isn't from oppressive governments but rather freedom from \_\_\_\_\_.
14. Our need isn't for the miracles but rather for the \_\_\_\_\_. Our need is for the living bread that satisfies the soul.
15. The living bread that Jesus offers, He gives by giving His body over to \_\_\_\_\_, that those who believe might have life and their souls satisfied.
16. Jesus' kingdom is not \_\_\_\_\_ of this world.
17. Jesus' reigns in the hearts of men and women who \_\_\_\_\_ by His word and \_\_\_\_\_ Him as Lord and Savior.
