A Most Curious Incident  
Genesis 30:25-43  
Series: Book of Beginnings - #34

1. Jacob's name means, " \_\_\_\_\_ " – an apt title for a man who practices deceit to get what he wants out of life at the expense of others.
2. Jacob's continual deceit \_\_\_\_\_ family relationships and Esau determines to kill him. In response, Jacob flees into the wilderness, to the land of his mother's people.
3. On the way, God comes to Jacob in a dream, promising him \_\_\_\_\_, descendants and a future blessing for all peoples. God also \_\_\_\_\_ to one day bringing Jacob back to the land of promise.
4. The 20 years that Jacob spends in his uncle's household will be difficult years of \_\_\_\_\_ building as Jacob discovers what it's like to be the \_\_\_\_\_ rather than the deceiver.
5. After 14 years of service, Jacob has nothing to his name. Laban, however, has \_\_\_\_\_ greatly during this time.
6. Laban, through \_\_\_\_\_, understands that he has prospered only because the blessing of the Lord rests on Jacob.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ practices, from the use of horoscopes and astrology, to séances and Ouija boards, find their origin in \_\_\_\_\_ forces other than God. They do not bring about the life which God calls us to and they have no place in the life of a Christian.
8. Jacob agrees to stay with Laban in return for the speckled and spotted animals of Laban's flocks. However, Laban immediately \_\_\_\_\_ these animals from his flocks and gives them to his sons rather than to Jacob.
9. Despite Jacob's desire to return home, God knows that he is not yet \_\_\_\_\_. He still has tw \_\_\_\_\_ o important lessons to learn before the Lord will lead him back to his homeland.
10. Jacob hasn't fully appreciated yet the brokenness and pain that \_\_\_\_\_ brings into relationships. He needs to learn that deceit can't be his "go to setting" when things aren't going his way.
11. Until Jacob learns better ways of \_\_\_\_\_ to the people in his life, he is always going to be \_\_\_\_\_ from someone or something.
12. Jacob needs to learn to wait upon the Lord; to trust in His \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
13. While we try to avoid them at all cost, the hard times we face may be the avenue by which God is actually in the process of \_\_\_\_\_ our prayers, and \_\_\_\_\_ His word to us.
14. In utilizing the branches to try to impact the genetics of the herds, Jacob is trying to \_\_\_\_\_, or control the situation, rather than \_\_\_\_\_ in God's provision.
15. If Jacob is to prosper, if he is to return home safely, he needs to learn to place his trust in the Lord. And Jacob will eventually learn that God has prospered him, not \_\_\_\_\_ of his trick with the branches, but \_\_\_\_\_ them.
16. Like Jacob we desire to take matters into our own hands and step out \_\_\_\_\_ of God, doing things in our own way, and in our own time ... and like Jacob we need to learn to \_\_\_\_\_ upon the Lord for His answers and His timing.
