The Dead in Christ - 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

Series: 1 Thessalonians #21

1. 1 and 2 Thessalonians are amongst the first of the New Testament books to be written being authored approximately _____ years after the death and resurrection of Jesus.
2. Every culture, every religion, every generation, has sought to answer the question of “What happens when we _____?”
3. For the Christian, the answer is irrevocably connected to _____ and to His _____.
4. The reality is that Jesus’ return is _____ although not necessarily _____.
5. The _____ of the church is that time yet to come, when Jesus will return, and all Christians who are alive at that time, will be caught up to be with Him forever.
6. The rapture is imminent in the sense that it could happen at any time – there are no _____ yet to be fulfilled before Jesus comes for His church.
